
## ADVANTAGES OF FEEDING NEW TREES WITH TABLETED NUTRIENTS


Speed, safety, effectiveness, efficiency and versatility — all these advantages are combined in Agriform Forest Tablets:

- 1. Speed No-measuring is required; the planter simply provides one fertilizer tablet for each planting hole. Planters can easily carry 100 or more tablets in an apron or knapsack. Placing a tablet with each seedling results in only a slight reduction in the rate of planting. A typical sequence is shown below, using a planting bar of a type preferred by forestry crews.
- Safety The slow-release nutrients in the tablets are compressed under many tons pressure. The tablets do not dissolve; instead, the tableted nutrients are gradually released by the action of soil bacteria. The risk of burning roots is negligible.


- 3. Effectiveness The unique formulation of these tablets provides 8 times the plant's need for nitrogen, 13 times the phosphorus need, and 4 times the potassium required to quadruple the size of a forest seedling during the first year after transplanting. But little of the surplus nutrients are wasted; most are slowly absorbed by the tree's roots.
- 4. Efficiency Very little of the nutrient content of these tablets is lost to leaching or fixation by soil chemicals, even in high rainfall areas.
- 5. Versatility These tablets will work in any kind of soil so long as there is sufficient moisture to permit root growth and sufficient soil bacteria to break down the tablets. Tablets are used in such diverse areas as Canada, South America, Japan, Malaysia, Australia and the Philippine Islands.
